Unlimited Happiness

Referred to as the happiest country in the world, Bhutan's landscape and lifestyle have attracted tourists from every continent.

While more openness to the world appears to be taking place, a recent change in the Constitution restricting public meetings of any sort has been interpreted as an attempt to curb faith-related gatherings that are not Buddhist - the religion followed by most of the population there.

Despite these severe restrictions, there is a growing network of underground churches all over Bhutan, with local travelling pastors encouraging believers and sharing the good news throughout the country.

A few months ago, we were introduced to one of those pastors. He told us how shortwave radio could help his efforts. With internet connectivity unreliable out of the big cities, radio offers a steadier way to deliver the good news of Jesus to villagers, complementing his periodical face-to-face ministry. After prayerful consideration, the pastor assembled a team of locals we were able to train in radio production. This was a massive operation given the precautions we had to take so to ensure the security of everyone involved.

Since then, this dedicated team have been working hard on writing and voicing over the newest program to be aired by Reach Beyond Australia. And its name couldn't have been more appropriate: 'Unlimited Happiness', a reference to the country's 'happiest country in the world' motto.

Spoken in Dzongkha, the language used by the majority of Bhutan's population, 'Unlimited Happiness' presents listeners with talks, music, and short stories that point to the joy that can be found in Jesus.

Thanks to the immense help of these new local ministry partners, we are now able to get closer to the ears of the Bhutanese. This is just the beginning. Plans are underway for a distribution of shortwave receivers in the country. Please pray for these bold initiatives and for everyone involved. 
