Rules of Play:

Ambrose Competition (White Markers)

Format

On every tee a player may hit a tee shot. The team then selects one of the tee shots from which to play. All members of the team may then hit from that position. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed.

Three Tee Shots

Each player must use a minimum of **three tee shots** per 18-hole round. The team captain (scorer) must record whose tee shot was used on each hole.

Selected shot

The position of the selected shot is marked. Each team member may then place their ball within one club length of the marked position, no nearer the hole, and play from this position.

If the selected ball is on the fairway, the fringe of the green or in hazard, bunker or rough, the team member's shots must be played from the same condition (i.e. a team member may not play from the fairway if the marked ball is in the rough).

On the putting green

The position of the selected ball is marked. Team members may place their ball within one putter head length of the marked position, no nearer the hole, and putt from this position. Once a ball is holed out no further strokes count.

Team Handicap

The handicap for a team of 4 is calculated by adding the handicaps of each team member and dividing the total combined handicap by 8 and is deducted from the final team stroke score. Players must use official Golf Link handicaps where available. If no formal handicap, a handicap reflective of the players true golfing ability will be allocated. A maximum individual handicap of 24 (men) and 27 (women) will be allocated.
